Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate order or direction to official respondents to conduct a proper and fair investigation in FIR No.167 dated 25.07.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325, & 326 IPC added subsequently, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that despite lodging of the FIR, investigation has not been done so far. Therefore, prayer for issuance of appropriate direction has been made.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3-State only.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. She, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, has stated that after registering the aforesaid FIR, Section 326 IPC has been

added on 10.08.2020 and thereafter, all the eight accused have been arrested in the present case. Therefore, petition, filed by petitioner, is misconceived.

Learned counsel for petitioner, on the basis of statement made by learned State counsel, states that he does not want to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.
