The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of
COVID 2019.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of FIR No. 126 dated 23.06.2020 under Sections 342 and 506
read with Section 34 IPC (Section 498-A added lateron), registered at Police
Station Nangal, District Rupnagar and all other consequential proceedings
arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of
compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as
learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned
State counsel and have gone through the record.

Vide order dated 09.09.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Area Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 09.11.2020 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nangal has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nangal and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that she is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Keeping in view the above facts, I am of the considered opinion that it is a fit case in which the impugned FIR is liable to be quashed.

Therefore, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 126 dated 23.06.2020 under Sections 342 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC (Section 498-A added lateron), registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
