Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.14 dated 24.01.2020 registered under Sections 420,506,406,201 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Moga.

On 08.09.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

“Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that only allegation levelled against the petitioner is that he also accompanied Reena Maan, Rajinder @ Mani Kumar her husband and Money Kumar to Jammu on 10.5.2019. It is further argued that there is no allegation against the petitioner either taking away scorio vehicle or money. The last submission made by counsel is that petitioner is ready to join investigation and co-operate throughout.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Adjourned to 5.11.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within seven days and on his appearance before the arresting/investigating officer, he shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the

concerned officer subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
- (iii) He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 08.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahib Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
