This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 193 dated 29.07.2020, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 326, 427, 379, 506, 148, & 149 IPC registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur Punjab. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 15.09.2020 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Inter-alia contends that brother of petitioner namely Jaspal also suffered injuries in the same very occurrence. Reference is made to MLR (P-7 and P-7/1).

Notice of motion for 23.11.2020. In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest,

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*the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
To be heard alongwith CRM-M-24298 of 2020.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the police authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel, on instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2020 is made absolute.
