The petitioners are the accused in FIR No.177 dated 21.08.2020 on the file of Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452, 148 and 149 IPC. By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, they seek quashing of the said FIR.

The petitioners claim that they compromised the matter with the two complainants, respondents No. 2 and 3 herein, and a compromise deed was executed to that effect on 22.08.2020.

Mr. Jagdeep Singh Rana, learned counsel, entered appearance for the complainants, respondents No.2 and 3, and filed his power of

attorney. He concedes that the matter has been settled by and between the parties and that his clients no longer wish to pursue the criminal proceedings launched against the petitioners.

Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, would state that no other cases are registered against the petitioners and they have no criminal antecedents.

Given the aforestated circumstances, as the fate of the case stands sealed by the settlement arrived at by and between the parties, there is no purpose served in the State wasting its resources in carrying it forward to its inevitable and futile conclusion.

The petition is accordingly allowed. FIR No.177 dated 21.08.2020 on the file of Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and all proceedings relating thereto are accordingly quashed.
