AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh and SHO, Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to look into the representation dated 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
