Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the representations dated 27/28/29.08.2020 (Annexures P-1 (1 to 6) and not to remove the existing structure of Mahu Distributory taking offs from right side of Nigana Canal at RD 16500-L under Jui Water Services Division Bhiwani and continue to supply water as per existing system.

In compliance to the order dated 04.09.2020, State has filed an affidavit of Executive Engineer, Jui Water Services Division, Bhiwani, wherein, it has been categorically stated that during the period when the repair work of distributaries would be carried out, no harm would be caused due to the repair work to the crops of the petitioners. Besides this, it has also been categorically stated that the repair work would be carried out during the closure period of the channel and farmers would not be deprived of water for irrigating their crops as they would continue to get their turn for water as

per the existing rotation programme.

Keeping in view the contents of the affidavit filed by the State, apprehension of the petitioners is unfounded and the grievance, if any, *qua* the repairs to be undertaken by the respondents stands redressed.

Petition stands disposed off accordingly.
