Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/ 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the services rendered on daily wage basis as Special Police Officer (SPO) for pensionary benefits.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has pointed out that instead of pressing the petition on merits, they would be satisfied, in case, legal notice dated 28.05.2020 (P-11) is decided by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that State has no objection, in case, the prayer of the petitioners is accepted.

Since the prayer made by the petitioners is innocuous and in view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case; this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the

present petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 28.05.2020 in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of three months from today.
