The petitioner Joginder Singh aged 61 years has filed the present petition *inter alia* seeking directions to respondents to release the full and final retiral benefits such as Gratuity, Leave Encashment, Arrears of salary etc., along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that for same/similar grievance as made in the writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a legal notice dated 02.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) followed by various representations including dated 14.07.2020 (P6). He further placed reliance on orders passed by this Court in CWP No.21521 of 2017, decided on 20.09.2017, titled as '**Budh Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others**'

(Annexure P-8) and in **CWP No.7964 of 2020**, decided on 11.06.2020, titled as '**Lakhwinder Singh Vs. Registrar Co-operative Societies Punjab and others**' (Annexure P-9).

Notice of motion. On the asking of Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents to consider and decide the petitioner's legal notice/representation within 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
