The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0072, dated 27.08.2019 registered under Section 454, 380 of Indian Penal Code and (Section 411 of IPC was added later on) at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Vide order dated 04.09.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation and there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
