Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0095 dated 03.11.2019 registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the main injury has been attributed to Lovepreet Kumar, who is alleged to have caused injury with the sieve meant for frying *pakora* on the person of Anil Goyal. As per the statement of the complainant, no injury has been attributed to the petitioner.

Copy of custody certificate by way of affidavit dated 05.10.2020 of the Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Mansa, submitted by the learned State counsel through email, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel points out that as per the FIR, a *dang* blow has been given by the petitioner on the back side of the neck region of Subhash Chand(since deceased) due to which he fell down on the ground and when shifted to hospital, he was declared as brought dead.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

It is not a case, where no injury is attributed to the petitioner. Rather as per the version of the FIR, before being shifted to the hospital, where the deceased was declared as brought dead, he had received a *dang* blow from the petitioner pursuant to which he fell on the ground. The allegations against the petitioner are grave in nature and this fact itself is sufficient enough to disentitle him the concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, no ground is made to allow the prayer of the petitioner.

Present petition is dismissed accordingly.
