Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take a decision on legal notice dated 16.03.2020 (Annexure P-14) submitted on behalf of the petitioners and any other additional grounds which may be submitted by them through a written representation.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take a decision on legal notice 16.03.2020 (Annexure P-14) submitted on behalf of the petitioners and any other additional grounds which may be submitted by them through a written representation, by passing a speaking order and after affording

opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of the supplementary representation to be made by the petitioners with additional grounds.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
