Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/
and 227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of
mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of
the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.7 and to take appropriate legal
action on representation dated 30.07.2020 moved by him(petitioner).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 20.02.2020,
when the petitioner, who was working with respondent No.7-Sonu, reached
at Lovekush Chowk on his motor-cycle, he had been waylaid by respondent
No.7 and his motor-cycle had been taken away by respondent No.7 on the
pretext that the petitioner owed money to respondent No.7.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he
would be satisfied, if representation dated 30.07.2020 (Annexure P-1),
moved by the petitioner, is decided by respondent No.5-Senior

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Superintendent of Police, Batala, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6.

In view of the aforesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, to decide the representation dated 30.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner within one month, in accordance with law, after receiving the copy of this order.
