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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 12 & 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondents for intentionally and deliberately violating order (Annexure P-1) dated 21.12.2018 in CWP No.6646 of 2018.

3. Learned counsel contends that on 21.12.2018, while issuing notice of the application (i.e. CM No.19259-CWP-2018 in CWP No.6646 of 2018) for 23.04.2019, it was ordered that the petitioners would continue to work and would not be replaced by another set of contractual employees, subject to their work and conduct being satisfactory but despite the aforementioned orders, the respondents withdrew work from the petitioners and also did not pay salary to them.

there is no violation of order (Annexure P-1) dated 21.12.2018, as the petitioners are still in the service and salary as per their entitlement except for the month of June 2020 has been paid to them while salary for the month of July 2020 would also be paid by 30.11.2020.

5. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case so warrant.

6. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as not pressed*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
