The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.160 dated 06.08.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 458, 34 IPC at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

The allegations are that the petitioner attacked the witness with slaps and kick blow. No weapon was used. No

specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. Notice of motion was issued on 08.09.2020 along with interim direction.

Learned State counsel duly assisted by learned counsel submits that the petitioner was also involved in a case under Section 302 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the said case, he has already been acquitted in the year 2018.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh.

In view of above, order dated 08.09.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required to do by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
