AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. By this petition, the petitioner has challenged the order Annexure P-10 which as per him has been passed on the basis of the minutes Annexure P-5 (as reflected in Agenda Item No.8) whereby a resolution has been passed for redistribution of areas of operation to work between him and private respondents. His basic grouse is that before recording these minutes or passing the order, the petitioner was never heard.

2. Mr.Deepak Balyan, Addl.A.G.Haryana, has very fairly accepted that petitioner should have been heard and states that he would have no objection if these orders are set aside with liberty to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to pass a fresh order in accordance with law after hearing the petitioner.

3. In the circumstances, this petition is allowed. The impugned order Annexure P-5 (qua Agenda Item No.8) and Order Annexure P-10

are set aside with direction to respondent No.1 to first hear the petitioner before passing any order. For this purpose, the petitioner through counsel is directed to appear before respondent No.1 on 08.10.2020 or any other date as and when his presence is required and thereafter, a fresh order be passed accordingly.
