The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 104 dated 20.05.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC, P.S. Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.08.2020 (Annexure P-2).

In compliance of the order dated 07.09.2020, a report has been received from the Court of Kanwal Kumar, Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sub Division, Bilaspur dated 20.10.2020. The factum of compromise as such has been verified and the complainant Maninder Singh and his brother Ravinder Singh, who were injured, appeared before the Court and made their statements that the compromise has been effected on 24.08.2020 without any pressure, greed, fear and to keep peace and harmony between the parties.

Keeping in view the above facts and the nature of allegations in the FIR, this Court is of the opinion that the case is squarely covered by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052.***

Accordingly, the petition is allowed. FIR No. 104 dated 20.05.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC, P.S. Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.
