Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred in violation of transfer policy and has sent a representation (Annexure P4) in this regard to the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jind, on 31.08.2020. He also contends that the petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide his representation (Annexure P4) in accordance with the transfer policy.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He contends that the representation (Annexure P4) has been sent to the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jind, while the competent authority to effect transfer is the Director General, State Transport, Haryana (respondent No. 2).

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to the Director General, State Transport, Haryana (respondent No. 2). In the event of the representation being filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the Director General, State Transport, Haryana (respondent No. 2) in accordance with the transfer policy by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of its receipt.
