This is the third petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 32 dated 26.03.2018 registered under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

The first petition viz. CRM-M-52087-2018 was dismissed vide order dated 21.01.2019 after noting the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the accused had been named after 1 ½ years of the death and that initially it was a case of accidental drowning. The second petition was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 29.07.2020 with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars. Hence, the present petition has been filed.

On being asked about the change in circumstances since the passing of order dated 21.01.2019 enabling the petitioner to maintain this petition, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are no changed circumstances.

Thus, the petition is not maintainable and is dismissed.
