The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.206 dated 3.8.2020, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur, under Section 18 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Short reply dated 18.9.2020 has been sent through email by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the aforementioned reply, the petitioner seeks liberty to surrender before the trial Court within seven days from today and to file an application for grant of regular bail, which may be ordered to be decided within a fixed time frame.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.

In case, an application for regular bail is moved by the petitioner at the time of surrender, the same shall be decided expeditiously and in any case, not later than seven days from the date thereof.
