Main case

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Hans Raj submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but has not cooperated since he is reluctant to get the disputed money allegedly taken by him to be recovered.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that actually no money was delivered to his client and the cheating, if any, was squarely done by his wife Karanjit Kaur against whom petitioner has himself lodged a criminal complaint.

Considering these circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioner at this stage is not called for. Consequently, the interim bail granted to the petitioner earlier is confirmed.
