The petitioner herein is aggrieved against the impugned order dated 07.10.2015 which is an appeal filed against the interim order dated 21.07.2015 whereby the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari had allowed interim maintenance to be paid by the respondent- husband under provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act.

The petitioner herein filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 dated 15.04.2015 and also sought interim maintenance. By an order dated 21.07.2015, an amount of Rs. 10000/- had been allowed as maintenance which was challenged by respondent No. 1 herein in an appeal. The Addl. Sessions Judge, Rewari modified the order dated 21.07.2015 and partly-allowed the appeal of respondent No.1 and reduced the interim maintenance from Rs. 10000/- to a sum of Rs. 4,000/-. Aggrieved against the said order, the instant petition has been filed.

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A reading of the last orders would reveal that either the matter was requested to be adjourned on various requests made by learned counsel for the petitioner or there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the subsequent date. Vide order dated 22.04.2019, the Court even directed the office not to entertain any adjournment slip as the matter was ordered to be listed for arguments.

The case has been called twice today, despite that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Since there is no assistance by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
