The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to transfer them from the place of present posting i.e. Shanan Power House, Joginder Nagar to the place of their choice i.e. BSL Projects, BBMB, Sundernagar, in terms of the decision dated 22.05.2000(Annexure P-1) and the office letter dated 16.12.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the petitioners have already spent more than the time framed in the policy, they ought to have been transferred to a station of their choice. He further submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners

have already submitted a legal notice dated 26.06.2020(Annexure P-4), but

no action has been taken on the said legal notice.

At this stage, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, D.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Secretary, Technical PSPCL, Patiala to take note of the contents of the legal notice dated 26.06.2020(Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with the relevant policy/guidelines framed by the respondents on the subject. The said exercise be carried out within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
