1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0220 dated 21.08.2020, registered under Section 61/1 under the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.09.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
