Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in support of his argument petitioner has filed an accompanied aforesaid affidavit by stating that there is no litigation pending between the petitioner and the private respondents. He states that petitioner is a 50% handicap and the private respondent No.4 had been threatening the petitioner that he would cause serious injuries to the petitioner and even he has threatened that in

case he does not withdraw the complaint which he has given to the police then he can even be murdered. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that even legal notice (Annexure P-2) on 13.08.2020 was given but no action has been taken by the concerned police officials.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of Court, Mr. H.S.Sitta, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State - respondents No.1 to 3 and states that State has no objection if the legal notice is decided in accordance with law.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, it is directed that Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar(Rural) shall look into the legal notice and take appropriate action if necessary and required in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
