Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Report dated 01.10.2020 of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent-Darshan Singh and accused/petitioners, namely, Gurdeep Singh and Manpinder Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue

influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.106 dated 19.05.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur District Sangrur under Sections 452, 506, 323, 188 of IPC and DDR No.16 dated 26.05.2020 vide which Section 458 of IPC was added later on and all consequences arising out of the said FIR and DDR *qua* the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
