Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to grant him the benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP Scheme) as formulated vide Policy Circular dated 03.11.2006 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the judgment dated 20.05.2013 passed by this Court in Jaswinder Singh Bedi & others vs. State of Punjab & others, CWP No.16446 of 2010 (Annexure P-5), whereby benefit of ACP Scheme was granted to the petitioners (therein). Subsequently, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 23.05.2017, disposed of CWP No.3011 of 2017, titled as Inderjit Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, (Annexure P-6) keeping in view the judgment passed in Jaswinder Singh Bedi's case (supra), by directing the respondents to take a final decision on the legal notice and pass speaking order thereon.

Learned counsel further refers to the office order dated

respondents as per judgment passed in **Inderjit Singh's** case (supra). In the present case, with regard to the grievance of petitioner, he has served a legal notice dated 06.01.2020 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondents.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.6 to look into the legal notice dated 06.01.2020 (Annexure P-8) and pass a speaking order thereon in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
