JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation/ complaint dated 6.7.2020 (Annexure P-3) and to provide police assistance/ protection for opening/ breaking the lock of the warehouse.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation/ complaint dated 6.7.2020 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to

the learned State counsel.

Again learned State counsel pleads no instructions in the matter.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation/ complaint dated 6.7.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to it, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to it, within a period of two weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
