Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the
petitioner, prays for withdrawal of the writ petition. He states that he may
be granted some time to be physically present and report at his place of
posting i.e. Eastern Command.

Assertion has also been made that the petitioner would make a
representation, after joining, for consideration for his transfer to a place
nearer to Chandigarh detailing therein the reasons supported with
documentary evidence as to why he is making such a request.

When this was put to the counsel for the respondents, who, on
instructions from Brig. N.K.Ohri, VSM, Dy. JAG Headquarters, Western
Command, states that in case the petitioner joins within a period of six days

from today at the place of his posting physically and makes a representation, as has been stated by the counsel for the petitioner, the said representation shall be considered sympathetically within a period of four weeks of the date of submission of the said representation.

In the light of the above statements of the counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file his representation and the parties would be bound by the statements made by their respective counsel.
