The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.81 dated 17.04.2020 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the neighbours.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural) in Court through e-mail, which is taken on record. It is stated in the reply that the complainant remained admitted in hospital from 15.04.2020 to 23.04.2020. Petitioner No.1 was armed with a *datar* and petitioner No.2 was armed with a baseball bat and they have caused injuries on the head of the complainant.

In view of the petitioners having caused injuries on the head of the complainant and the complainant remained admitted in hospital for about 10 days, I do not find the petitioners entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
