REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has invoked jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of order dated 30.04.2020 (Annexure P1) whereby he has been transferred to Karnal.

Counsel representing State of Haryana would submit that petitioner was transferred in the month of April, 2020 and he never made any representation to a competent authority to express his grievance qua his transfer. He would pray that the present petition may be disposed of but with liberty to the petitioner to make detailed representation to the competent authority expressing his grievance against transfer and the same would be disposed of, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the petitioner would state that he wrote a letter to District Food and Civil Supply and Consumer Affair Controller, Kurukshetra a copy whereof is Annexure P4. He would further state that a communication was addressed by Assistant Food and Civil Supply and Consumer Affair Officer, Ladwa to District Food and Civil Supply and Consumer Affair Controller, Kurukshetra (Annexure P5).

Perusal of the documents Annexures P4 and P5 would reveal that the same are dated 07.08.2020 meaning thereby that the petitioner did not express his grievance against his transfer for about three months.

Without examining merits of the case, the petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is left at liberty to make a detailed representation

to respondent No.2 within a week. In case any such representation is made, the same shall be decided by the authority concerned within a period of 10 days from the date of its receipt.
