Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to arrest respondent No.5 (wrongly written as respondent No.4), recover the daughter of the petitioner and to present report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.0007 dated 09.01.2018 under Sections 363, 366, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, Annexure P-3.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position even on the previous dates i.e. on 28.01.2019, 08.08.2019 and 24.10.2019.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Rajwinder Singh, submits that in the aforesaid FIR, police has already investigated the matter and had prepared a cancellation report and the same had already been submitted to the court on 13.03.2018, which is now pending consideration

before the Magistrate on 04.04.2020. He further states that at the time of registration of the FIR, statement of the prosecutrix was recorded, wherein she has stated that she is major and she had solemnized marriage on 07.01.2018 with Satnam Singh, respondent No.5.

Since no one is present on behalf of the petitioner, in the light of statement made by learned State Counsel, the present petition is disposed of at this stage.
