The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.198 dated 31.07.2020 under Sections 332, 353, 186, 379-B, 34 IPC (Section 323 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and there is variation in the sequence of events in the FIR as well as in the Challan Receipt and the petitioner has not been named in the FIR.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner, this Court finds that the allegations made against the petitioner are serious in nature. The petitioner has not only caused interference in the discharge of duty of police personnel but he has also allegedly torn off the uniform of police officials and ran away with the truck, which was parked at Toll Plaza and was in the custody of police Constable, along with other co-accused.

Therefore, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
