Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing
due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of
India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to official respondents
to provide passage to the petitioner after demarcation of the land as
respondent No.6 has illegally encroached upon the passage which goes to
the field of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner
will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction may be issued
to respondent Nos.2 and 3-Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala and Sub
Divisional Magistrate Kapurthala respectively to decide his claim as raised
in the representations dated 19.06.2020 and 11.08.2020 (Annexures P-1 and
P-2).

Without commenting upon the merits of this case or about the
entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in

the representations dated 19.06.2020 and 11.08.2020 (Annexures P-1 and P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents Nos.2 and 3-Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala and Sub Divisional Magistrate Kapurthala to decide the said representations within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
