The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 73 dated 21.01.2020 registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 285, 323, 365, 307, 201, 379-B, 34 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for almost 09 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not yet been framed. There are two other cases pending against the petitioner but he has been granted regular bail in the said cases. Thus, the petitioner may be granted regular bail in this case also.

Custody certificate dated 24.10.2020 produced in Court. The same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has

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undergone actual custody of 09 months and there are two other cases pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that the charges have not yet been framed. He also does not dispute the fact that the petitioner is on bail in the other pending cases.

It is thus, evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and that the petitioner is on bail in the other pending cases. No useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody indefinitely.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
