Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of order dated 21.09.2012 passed by the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, vide which the petitioners have been wrongly declared proclaimed persons in case FIR No. 92 dated 08.08.2010 registered under Sections 420 IPC at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are residing in Uttar Pradesh (UP) and are husband and wife and were not in the knowledge of the proceedings in the aforesaid FIR pending before the Courts at Ajnala.

At this stage, Mr. Vivek Singla, Advocate, appearing on behalf of Mr. Deepanshu Sodhi, Advocate for respondent No. 2 states that a compromise has been effected between the complainant-Harvinder Singh and the petitioners. Petitioners and respondent No. 2, who are present in the Court have not disputed the factum of compromise.

It is further stated that three other co-accused in the present case have been acquitted as the witnesses had turned hostile. He further states that the petitioners are ready to face the trial and prays that the trial Court be directed to admit them to bail.

Learned State counsel states that the proclamation order was passed way back on 21.09.2012.

In view of the above, the petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court within ten days and on their doing so the trial Court shall admit them to bail on furnishing adequate surety/bail bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioners shall also deposit costs of Rs.10,000/- in the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh.
