This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 2 is 33 years old lady and her husband is residing in Australia and petitioner No. 1 is her daughter. He further submits that petitioner No. 2 was being ill-treated in her matrimonial home and now she is residing in a rented accommodation at Nabha and respondents No. 4 and 5 are her parents, who
