Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the instant petition has been rendered as infructuous as final order has been passed by the Court below in the petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn the attention of this Court to order dated 06.03.2019 whereby the respondent had been directed to clear the entire arrears of maintenance which were due and which the respondent had failed to do. However, it is not disputed that due to non-compliance of order of this Court, dated 06.03.2019, the petitioner has already preferred a contempt petition before this Court under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

In the circumstances, no further order is called for in the instant matter since the matter already stands disposed of by the Court below.
