All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

An affidavit of the SSP, Fazilka, stated to have been received in terms of the order dated September 30, 2020, has been sent to me by the Reader of this court, alongwith a drive stated to be containing the video recording.

As regards the affidavit of the SSP, it has been stated therein that the said compact disc contains five video clips and that the relevant video clip shows the alleged detainee (Krishan Lal) entering and leaving the police station within short durations on 02.09.2020, between 11:42 a.m. and 6:11 p.m.

The affidavit further states that an enquiry was made by the SSP, with the SP, Head Quarters, also asked to visit the police station and to check the CCTV cameras, and that the SSP was satisfied that no illegality or impropriety was committed by the police.

Though, seemingly at least, only one entry and exit point to the police station has been shown in the video recording, yet, keeping in view the above as also the statement of the alleged detainee annexed with the reply filed earlier by the DSP, without making any further comment on the matter, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
