The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.04 dated 03.01.2020 under Sections 307/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been implicated in the case and nothing is recovered from him in the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There are specific allegations against the petitioner that he along with other co-accused attacked the complainant with fire arms with an intention to kill, wherein Attinderpal Singh @ Honey received a fire arm injury on his head.

Therefore, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.
