This is second petition for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 261 dated 1.11.2017 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

The first petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 5.4.2019.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that the petitioner has already suffered three convictions under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. He further informs the Court that the petitioner is a habitual offender as he is involved in as many as 11 criminal cases.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it appropriate to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Hence, dismissed.
