The mainstay of claim made by the petitioner is that he has secured 61 marks in written examination and entitle to benefit of 5 marks of EWS category, therefore, entitle to be selected and appointed as Clerk in the said category.

Counsel representing the respondents would state that representation (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioner is pending consideration and the same shall be decided within a period of 5 days.

Without examining merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction that respondent No.2 shall decide representation (Annexure P-7) within a period of 5 days. In case claim of the petitioner is found to be meritorious and the petitioner is held entitle to selection as Clerk, his right shall not be prejudiced irrespective of the selected candidates having joined in pursuance of letters of appointment

issued to them. In case representation of the petitioner is rejected, he may take recourse to appropriate remedy, in law.
