In terms of order dated 09.07.2020 passed in CRM-M-14566-2020 (Amrinder Singh vs. State of Punjab), the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of two months on medical grounds and he was directed to surrender on or before 10.09.2020.

Through present petition, the petitioner is seeking extension of interim bail on the score that the petitioner is still under treatment.

On the last date of hearing, it has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the interim bail may be extended only for a period of two months and, thereafter, further extension will not be sought.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner is getting treatment as an outdoor patient only. However, it has not been disputed that in view of categorical undertaking by learned counsel for the petitioner, the interim bail may be extended for a period of two months only.

In these set of circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner in terms of the order dated 09.07.2020 is extended for a period of two months and the petitioner will surrender on or before 10.11.2020.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
