Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No. 2/accused Amtoj Singh, vide order dated 04.05.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka in case/FIR No. 38 dated 22.04.2019, under Sections 457, 380, 427, 447, 511, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/complainant submits that after the anticipatory bail was granted to respondent No. 2/accused Amtoj Singh, he is extending threat to the petitioner/complainant and other witnesses.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2/accused has given an undertaking that respondent No. 2/accused will not extend any threat to complainant or any other witnesses.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh,

has submitted that no recent application has been received on behalf of the petitioner/complainant regarding any threat being extended by respondent No.2/accused and the only application was the one which was submitted immediately after the anticipatory bail was granted to respondent No.2/accused.

In view of the undertaking given by learned counsel for respondent No. 2/accused that he will not extend any threat to petitioner/complainant or any other witnesses, this petition is disposed of at this stage granting liberty to the petitioner/complainant to approach Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka in case any further threat is extended to him.

Liberty is also granted to petitioner to file a fresh petition, if so required.
