Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.8 dated 13.03.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 30.05.2019 passed by this Court, while issuing notice of motion in the case, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear on 23.07.2019.

A report dated 04.02.2020 has been received from the Mediator, wherein it is mentioned that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement vide settlement/agreement dated 04.02.2020.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediator, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.05.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

The settlement/agreement dated 04.02.2020 be made part of the record.

The parties shall adhere to the terms of the settlement/agreement dated 04.02.2020 in letter and spirit.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
