All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Notice of motion having been issued on 10.09.2020, with a direction also given that the competent authority amongst the respondents would pass a detailed speaking order on the representation/complaint made by the petitioner, Mr. Mahajan, learned senior counsel, appears for respondents no. 2 and 3, i.e. the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram and the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, respectively, and submits that in fact a detailed speaking order has been passed on 23.09.2020, i.e. yesterday, rejecting the case of the petitioner, on the ground that there is a violation of the statutory bye-laws.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact there is no violation of the bye-laws but since an order has been passed, he seeks to withdraw this petition, with liberty to file a fresh one challenging the said order, and if necessary, also the bye-laws concerned.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty granted.
