Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take into consideration representation dated NIL (Annexure P/3) moved by the petitioner with further direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated NIL (postal receipt shows that it was conveyed on 30.06.2020) to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into and decide representation dated NIL (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
