The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to provide the benefit of Post Matric Scholarship to the petitioner.

Learned counsel the petitioner submits that the petitioner is eligible in all aspects to be benefited with Post Matric Scholarship and is covered under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarships to the students belonging to Scheduled Castes for studies in India. He further submits the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 28.06.2020 (Annexure P-2), but no decision thereof has been taken by the respondents to consider her case under Post Matric Scholarship scheme.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ranjana Shahi, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents.

Heard.

Present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department, to take a final decision on the representation dated 28.06.2020 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, preferably within a period of 3 months from today.

The petitioner shall be informed about the decision taken on his representation.
