Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 306 dated 23.12.2018 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Samrala, Khanna.

The case was called twice but there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the recovery of 1 kg *Heroin* each was effected from the possession of the petitioner and the co-accused. As per the FSL report, the recovered contraband falls under commercial quantity. He further submits that out of 13 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

The recovered contraband falls under the commercial quantity. Section 37 of the NDPS Act, bars the grant of bail to the accused in the case of commercial quantity.

In view of the above, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of regular bail.

The present petition is dismissed.
