This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to register a FIR against respondent NO.4 for the offences under Sections 323,324,268,352,385,386,506 IPC and Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 in the incident that took place on 8.6.2020 wherein respondent No.4 assaulted the petitioner to extort illegal gratification and for issuance of further direction to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the police officials. A further is made to take action on the representations dated 9.6.2020 (Annexure P-2) and dated 16.8.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG., Punjab who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the State.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondent No.2 to look into the

representations dated 9.6.2020 (Annexure P-2) and dated 16.8.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 –Senior Superintendent of Police, Taran Taran to look into the representations dated 9.6.2020 (Annexure P-2) and dated 16.8.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today.
